- 2) No use or possession of drugs, unless prescribed by a licensed physician, including alcohol and marijuana. Submit to random UA/Breathalyzer testing.
- 3) Keep in contact with your attorney ~~and your probation/parole officer if on formal supervision.~~
- 4) Be aware of and attend all court dates. in person
- 5) Maintain or seek full time work/school or a combination of both.
- 6) No direct or indirect contact with victims, any of the state's witnesses, or co-defendants.
- 7) Do not leave the TRI-COUNTY AREA without prior written permission from CSS, PO and/or the Court.
- 8) Maintain access to a telephone and notify CSS prior to any changes of:  
Address, telephone number, living situation, employment and when I receive notice of court appearances.
- 9) Be subject to search of person, vehicle, and premise while under CSS.
- 10) Cooperate and comply with Home/Office Visits while under CSS.
- 11) Not possess any weapons or ammunition.
- 12) Not enter any establishments that sell alcohol as the primary source of revenue.
- 13) Not drive without a valid driver's license, insurance or registration.

## **Wheeler County District Attorney Report**

### **Community Safety Notice – August 6, 2020**

On April 11, 2019, Mitchell Grandlund, 34 years old, formerly of Oregon City and now residing in Mitchell, Oregon, was arraigned in Multnomah County Circuit Court on ten counts of encouraging child sex abuse 1, ten counts of encouraging child sex abuse 2 and misdemeanor possession of methamphetamine.

Mr. Grandlund will reside in Mitchell pending his trial. Mr. Grandlund is presumed innocent unless proven guilty. Mr. Grandlund's case is out of Multnomah County. He will be tried in Multnomah County. The following is information about the criminal proceedings of Mr. Grandlund's case and the conditions of his release pending trial.

As part of a federal task force investigation, Portland Police Bureau and the FBI investigated Mr. Grandlund for internet child pornography. Mr. Grandlund worked as a custodian at Madison High School in Portland. Law enforcement arrested Mr. Grandlund on April 10, 2019.

At arraignment, the Multnomah County Circuit Court set bail at \$255,000 in case number 19CR23886. Mr. Grandlund was indicted and arraigned on the indictment on April 19, 2019. Mr. Grandlund remained in custody for sixteen months, from his arrest on April 10, 2019 until August 5, 2020. On that day, the Multnomah County Circuit Court reduced bail and allowed him to move to Mitchell to live with his mother pending his trial.

While in custody, the court referred Mr. Grandlund to the Multnomah County Sheriff Office Close Street Supervision (CSS) program for an evaluation and release recommendation. CSS returned the referral as they are staffed for 125 but had over 300 people to evaluate and supervise. At the release hearing on May 14, 2019, the court denied defense counsel's motion to reduce bail. On August 2, 2019, Mr. Grandlund waived his right to a speedy trial and remained in custody.

On October 23, 2019, the trial set for October 28 was set over to December 3, 2019, which date was later continued to January 6, 2020, February 10, 2020 and February 24, 2020 when it was taken off the trial docket for possible resolution, which did not happen. The court set reappearance for February 28, 2020. On March 12, 2020, the court appointed substitute counsel for Mr. Grandlund. The court set the next appearance for March 19, 2020.

Then on August 4, 2020, the court held another release hearing. The court reduced bail to \$25,000 and modified the conditions of release. Multnomah County Circuit Court Judge Eric Dahlin ordered Multnomah County Sheriff Office Close Street Supervision to do a home visit by August 18, 2020 if Mr. Grandlund posts bail, which was 10% of \$25,000, or \$2,500, which he did. The judge ordered Mr. Grandlund to be released if he posted bail even if the home inspection did not happen.

**The release conditions are that Mr. Grandlund is to live with his mother who lives in Mitchell, Oregon. He is not to have internet access for any purpose. He is to have no contact with children under age 18, or to be within 500 feet of a school, park, or anywhere that children congregate. He is to have GPS monitoring through Close Street Supervision or their designee.**
